## Required Skills, Experience and Qualifications

- Good with people you'll need the ability to build positive relationships with pupils, staff, and parents.
- Effective communicators clear and confident verbal and written communication skills.
- Team players the role needs a good team player who is passionate about supporting learning

You must have been resident in England for the last three years and have the right to work in the UK.

#### For apprentices aged 16-18

- Grade C or above or 4/5 at GCSE in English
- Grade C or above or 4/5 at GCSE in Maths

If you don't meet the above criteria you will need to work towards your Level 2 Functional Skills as part of your apprenticeship.

Functional Skills Level 2: An alternative to GCSEs and equivalent to a Grade 4. We can support you if you'd like to gain these qualifications.

#### For apprentices aged 19+

• No qualifications are required if you are aged 19+ (although it is desirable to have Maths and English GCSE at Grade C/Level 4 or above)

To become a PE Teacher: You'll need GCSEs (grade 4/C+) in English, Maths, and Science for primary, plus a bachelor's degree in any subject. Without a degree, you can choose a Teacher Degree Apprenticeship (Note: Alevels will be required).

### Applying for an apprenticeship

You can apply for an apprenticeship while you're still at school but you'll need to be 16 or over by the end of the summer holidays to start the apprenticeship.
